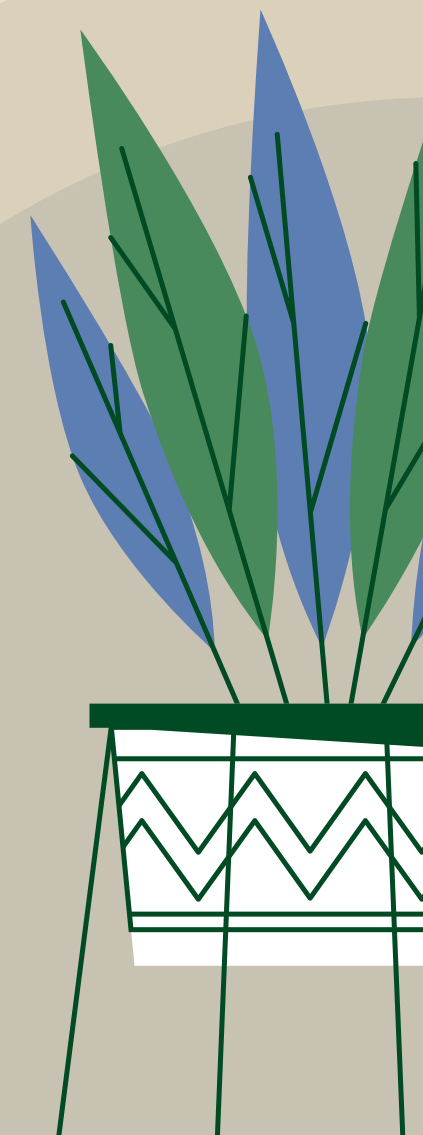
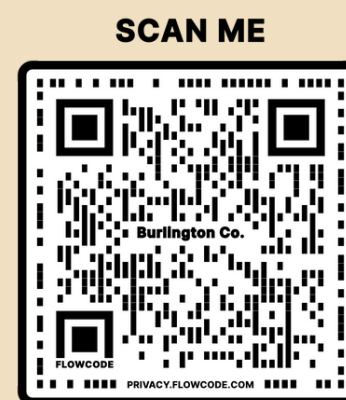
BURLINGTON COUNTY AMERICAN JOB CENTER

O*NET INTEREST PROFILER

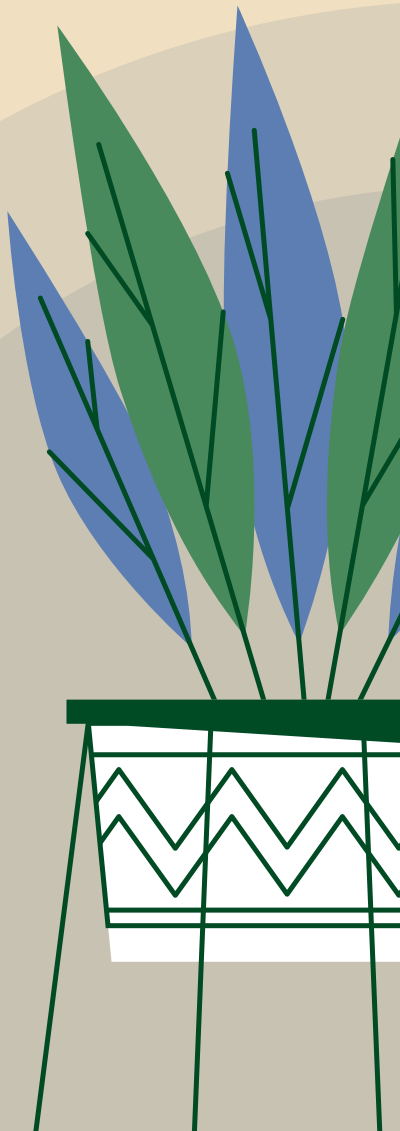

NJ UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE

Unemployment Insurance (UI) is a program that gives financial support to people who lose their jobs through no fault of their own. To qualify for Unemployment Insurance benefits, you must meet all of the eligibility requirements of the New Jersey Unemployment Compensation Law. Those who meet the requirements may receive benefits for up to 26 weeks during a one-year period.

The state's welfare reform program, WorkFirst NJ, emphasizes work as the first step toward building a new life and a brighter future. Our goal is to help people get off welfare, secure employment and become self-sufficient, through job training, education and work activities. WFNJ provides temporary cash assistance and many other support services to families through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program.
